Portable Sink – Startup



If storing in temperatures below 33 degrees Fahrenheit; all water must be completely drained from the system or it will freeze and cause damage.

If water freezes any of the following parts can be damaged; heater, faucets, water lines and pump.

Turning the heater thermostat up before filling with water will cause damage.

Parts damaged by neglect or abuse are not covered under warranty.

- 1. This unit ships as fully tested and inspected.
- 2. Determine the location where the sink will be located.
- 3. Unpackage the sink; lift the sink stand with two people when possible.

a. *DO NOT USE FAUCET OR KNOBS AS A HANDLE*

- 4. Turn the water heater thermostat all the way to the left.
 - a. *DO NOT TURN UP THERMOSTAT HEATER WHEN EMPTY*
- 5. Remove the pump intake line from the 6 gallon jug and fill with water and reinstall.
- 6. Attach faucet to the top of the sink cabinet.
- 7. Turn both hot and cold water faucet knobs all the way open (clockwise).
- 8. Plug sink cabinet GFCI adapter into a nearby outlet.
- 9. Water will start to flow out the faucet, shut off the cold water knobs only.
 - a. Now, wait while the air is purged from the hot water tank as it fills.
 - b. Once water starts to run from the faucet again, turn off the hot water knob.
- 10. If the hot water temperature is below 100 degrees Fahrenheit, increase the thermostat by turning the thermostat knob right slightly, wait 15 minutes and re-check temperature.

11.DO NOT ADD MORE THAN 6 GALLONS OF WATER TO THE STAND AT ANY TIME.

- 12. Always empty the waste jug before refilling the fresh water container.
- 13. When storing or not in operation, empty all water from the stand.
- 14. STAND SHOULDN'T BE USED OR STORED IN FREEZING TEMPERATURES
